CHAPTER 111

An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-746.4 of the Code of Virginia, relating to special license plates for members of the Special Forces Association.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 46.2-746.4 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 46.2-746.4. Special license plates for members of certain military veterans' organizations.

On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a member of any of the following military veterans' organizations, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to the members of the following organizations: the American Legion, the Disabled American Veterans, the Legion of Valor of the USA, the Marine Corps League, the First Marine Division Association, the Retired Officers Association, *the Special Forces Association, the Veterans of the Battle of Iwo Jima*, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, and the Vietnam Veterans of America.

The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued to members of the Legion of Valor of the USA under this section.
