| 11 | 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 56-408.1 as follows: |
| 12 | § 56-408.1. Limitation on closure of certain private railroad grade crossings. |
| 13 | Any private railroad grade crossing that: (i) provides the only recorded means of ingress and egress |
| 14 | for a parcel of land, (ii) was in existence on January 1, 1990, and had been in existence for at least |
| 15 | twenty-five years prior to that date, and (iii) is located in a county having a population of at least |
| 16 | 17,000 but less than 17,400 shall constitute a valid right-of-way or easement for ingress and egress by |
| 17 | the owner of the affected parcel of land. No railroad company shall discontinue, close, remove, or |
| 18 | otherwise prevent the continued use of any such crossing by any such landowner without such |
| 19 | landowner's written permission. |

20 For the purpose of this section, a "private railroad grade crossing" is a railroad grade crossing 21 where the road crossing the railroad is not a public road and is not part of any public highway system.
