11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 46.2-665 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
13	§ 46.2-665. Vehicles used for agricultural or horticultural purposes.
14	A. No person shall be required to obtain the registration certificate, license plates and decals, or pay
15	a registration fee for any motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer used exclusively for agricultural or
16 17	horticultural purposes on lands owned or leased by the vehicle's owner. B. This exemption shall only apply to vehicles which are not operated on or over any public
18	highway in this Commonwealth for any purpose other than:
19	1. Crossing a highway;
20	2. Operating along a highway for a distance of no more than thirty miles from one part of the
21	owner's land to another, irrespective of whether the tracts adjoin; OF
22	3. Taking the vehicle or attached fixtures to and from a repair shop for repairs; or
23	4. Operating along a highway to and from a refuse disposal facility for the purpose of disposing of
24	trash and garbage generated on a farm.
