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Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 9-6.25:1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 62.1-132.11:2 as follows:

§ 9-6.25:1. Advisory boards, commissions and councils.

 - § 62.1-132.11:2. Maritime Incident Response Advisory [Committee Board] established; duties; composition; appointment; terms.
 - There is hereby created the Maritime Incident Response Advisory Committee to provide guidance in the management of maritime fire and incident issues in the Commonwealth. The Maritime Incident Response Advisory Board is hereby established and is hereafter referred to as the Board. The purpose of the Board shall be to recommend and direct the development of goals, objectives, policies and plans needed to develop and improve management of maritime fire and incident issues in Hampton Roads and throughout the Commonwealth. This shall include recommendations for the use of state general funds for essential equipment and operation costs, including personnel, material, maintenance, supplies and training to promote an effective and efficient firefighting and incident management force. The Committee shall be composed of [thirteen fourteen] members appointed by the Governor as follows: one representative of the Chesapeake Fire Department; one representative of the Chesterfield County Fire Department, one representative of the Hampton Division of Fire and Response, one representative of the Newport News Fire Department, one representative of the Norfolk Department of Fire and Paramedical Services, one representative of the Portsmouth Fire Department, one representative of the Virginia Beach Department of Fire, one representative of the York County Department of Fire and Life Safety, one representative of the Hampton Roads Maritime Association, one representative of the Hampton Roads Maritime Incident Response Team, one representative of the Virginia Port Authority, the Executive Director of the Port Authority or his designee [, the Commissioner of Marine Resources or his designee,] and one citizen member.

Initial appointments shall be made as follows: four members shall be appointed for two years, five members shall be initially appointed for three years, and four members shall be appointed for four-year terms. The Governor shall designate the term to be served by each appointee at the time of appointment. Thereafter, all members shall be appointed for terms of four years each. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired terms. No member shall be eligible to serve more than two successive four-year terms; however, after expiration of a term of three years or less, or after the expiration of the remainder of a term to which he was appointed to fill a vacancy, two additional terms may be served by such member if appointed thereto.

The Advisory Board shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its members. Members of the Advisory Board shall receive no compensation for their services as members of the Advisory Board, but the nongovernmental member shall receive reasonable expenses. Upon the request of the Advisory Board, such staff support as is necessary for the conduct of the Advisory Board's business shall be furnished by the Port Authority.
