Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 9-6.25:1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 62.1-132.11:2 as follows:

§ 9-6.25:1. Advisory boards, commissions and councils.

 140 A. [~~There is hereby created the Maritime Incident Response Advisory Committee to provide~~
 141 ~~guidance in the management of maritime fire and incident issues in the Commonwealth. The Maritime~~
 142 ~~Incident Response Advisory Board is hereby established and is hereafter referred to as the Board. The~~
 143 ~~purpose of the Board shall be to recommend and direct the development of goals, objectives, policies~~
 144 ~~and plans needed to develop and improve management of maritime fire and incident issues in Hampton~~
 145 ~~Roads and throughout the Commonwealth. This shall include recommendations for the use of state~~
 146 ~~general funds for essential equipment and operation costs, including personnel, material, maintenance,~~
 147 ~~supplies and training to promote an effective and efficient firefighting and incident management force.]~~
 148 The Committee shall be composed of [~~thirteen~~ fourteen] members appointed by the Governor as
 149 follows: one representative of the Chesapeake Fire Department; one representative of the Chesterfield
 150 County Fire Department, one representative of the Hampton Division of Fire and Response, one
 151 representative of the Newport News Fire Department, one representative of the Norfolk Department of
 152 Fire and Paramedical Services, one representative of the Portsmouth Fire Department, one
 153 representative of the Virginia Beach Department of Fire, one representative of the York County
 154 Department of Fire and Life Safety, one representative of the Hampton Roads Maritime Association, one
 155 representative of the Hampton Roads Maritime Incident Response Team, one representative of the
 156 Virginia Port Authority, the Executive Director of the Port Authority or his designee [, the
 157 Commissioner of Marine Resources or his designee,] and one citizen member.
 158 Initial appointments shall be made as follows: four members shall be appointed for two years, five
 159 members shall be initially appointed for three years, and four members shall be appointed for four-year
 160 terms. The Governor shall designate the term to be served by each appointee at the time of appointment.
 161 Thereafter, all members shall be appointed for terms of four years each. Vacancies shall be filled for
 162 the unexpired terms. No member shall be eligible to serve more than two successive four-year terms;
 163 however, after expiration of a term of three years or less, or after the expiration of the remainder of a
 164 term to which he was appointed to fill a vacancy, two additional terms may be served by such member
 165 if appointed thereto.
 166 The Advisory Board shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its members. Members of
 167 the Advisory Board shall receive no compensation for their services as members of the Advisory Board,
 168 but the nongovernmental member shall receive reasonable expenses. Upon the request of the Advisory
 169 Board, such staff support as is necessary for the conduct of the Advisory Board's business shall be
 170 furnished by the Port Authority.
