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**HOUSE BILL NO. 1192****AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE**

*A BILL to amend and reenact § 9-6.25:1 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 62.1-132.11:2, relating to the establishment of the Maritime Incident Response Advisory Board.*

**Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

**1. That § 9-6.25:1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 62.1-132.11:2 as follows:**

§ 9-6.25:1. Advisory boards, commissions and councils.

There shall be, in addition to such others as may be designated in accordance with § 9-6.25, the following advisory boards, commissions and councils within the executive branch:

 135 § 62.1-132.11:2. *Maritime Incident Response Advisory Board established; duties; composition;*  
 136 *appointment; terms.*  
 137 *A. The Maritime Incident Response Advisory Board is hereby established and is hereafter referred to*  
 138 *as the Board. The purpose of the Board shall be to recommend and direct the development of goals,*  
 139 *objectives, policies and plans needed to develop and improve management of maritime fire and incident*  
 140 *issues in Hampton Roads and throughout the Commonwealth. This shall include recommendations for*  
 141 *the use of state general funds for essential equipment and operation costs, including personnel, material,*  
 142 *maintenance, supplies and training to promote an effective and efficient firefighting and incident*  
 143 *management force. The Board shall be composed of fourteen members appointed by the Governor as*  
 144 *follows: one representative of the Chesapeake Fire Department, one representative of the Chesterfield*  
 145 *County Fire Department, one representative of the Hampton Division of Fire and Response, one*  
 146 *representative of the Newport News Fire Department, one representative of the Norfolk Department of*  
 147 *Fire and Paramedical Services, one representative of the Portsmouth Fire Department, one*  
 148 *representative of the Virginia Beach Department of Fire, one representative of the York County*  
 149 *Department of Fire and Life Safety, one representative of the Hampton Roads Maritime Association, one*  
 150 *representative of the Hampton Roads Maritime Incident Response Team, one representative of the*  
 151 *Virginia Port Authority, the Executive Director of the Port Authority or his designee, the Commissioner*  
 152 *of Marine Resources or his designee, and one citizen member.*  
 153 *Initial appointments shall be made as follows: four members shall be appointed for two years, five*  
 154 *members shall be initially appointed for three years, and five members shall be appointed for four-year*  
 155 *terms. The Governor shall designate the term to be served by each appointee at the time of appointment.*  
 156 *Thereafter, all members shall be appointed for terms of four years each. Vacancies shall be filled for*  
 157 *the unexpired terms. No member shall be eligible to serve more than two successive four-year terms;*  
 158 *however, after expiration of a term of three years or less, or after the expiration of the remainder of a*  
 159 *term to which he was appointed to fill a vacancy, two additional terms may be served by such member*  
 160 *if appointed thereto.*  
 161 *The Board shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its members. Members of the*  
 162 *Board shall receive no compensation for their services as members of the Board, but the*  
 163 *nongovernmental member shall receive reasonable expenses. Upon the request of the Board, such staff*  
 164 *support as is necessary for the conduct of the Board's business shall be furnished by the Port Authority.*
