A *BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 58.1-3650.848 and 58.1-3650.849, designating certain organizations to be exempt from property taxation.*

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 58.1-3650.848 and 58.1-3650.849 as follows:

§ 58.1-3650.848. *Property of The Good Shepherd Alliance, Inc.*

A. *The Good Shepherd Alliance, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.*

B. *Real property located in Loudoun County, owned by The Good Shepherd Alliance, Inc. and used by it exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.*

§ 58.1-3650.849. *Property of The International Society of Air Safety Investigators.*

A. *The International Society of Air Safety Investigators, a nonprofit organization, is hereby designated as a benevolent organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.*

B. *Personal property located in Loudoun County, owned by The International Society of Air Safety Investigators and used by it exclusively for benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.*
