15	§ 18.2-35. How voluntary manslaughter punished.
16	Voluntary manslaughter is punishable as a Class 5 felony. However, if the victim is under the age of
17	five, it shall be punishable as a Class 4 felony.
18	[§ 18.2-57.4. Assault and battery against an infant under the age of five.
19	Any person over the age of fourteen who commits an assault and battery against a person under the
20	age of five which results in severe bodily injury or permanent and significant physical impairment is
21	guilty of a Class 5 felony.]
