	1. That § 51.1-212 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
13 14	§ 51.1-212. Definitions.
15	As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:
16	"Employee" means any (i) member of the Capitol Police Force as described in § 30-34.2:1, (ii)
17	campus police officer appointed under the provisions of Chapter 17 (§ 23-232 et seq.) of Title 23, (iii)
18	game warden in the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries appointed under the provisions of Chapter
19	2 (§ 29.1-200 et seq.) of Title 29.1, (iv) special agent of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control
20	appointed under the provisions of Chapter 1 (§ 4.1-100 et seq.), (v) law-enforcement officer employed
21	by the Virginia Marine Resources Commission as described in § 9-169, (vi) correctional officer as the
22	term is defined in § 53.1-1, and including correctional officers employed at a juvenile correction facility
23	as the term is defined in § 66-25.3, (vii) any parole officer appointed pursuant to § 53.1-143, (viii)
24	probation officer employed by the Department of Juvenile Justice whose duties are described in
25 26	§ 16.1-237, and (viii) (ix) any commercial vehicle enforcement officer employed by the Department of State Police.
20 27	"Member" means any person included in the membership of the Retirement System as provided in
28	this chapter.
<u>29</u>	"Normal retirement date" means a member's sixtieth birthday.
30	"Retirement System" means the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System.
31	2. That the present value of benefits accrued on behalf of members of the Virginia Retirement
32	System who become members of the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System by virtue of this
33	act, and on the effective date of this act, shall be transferred from the assets of the Virginia

act, and on the effective date of this act, shall be transferred fro Retirement System to the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System.
