That [ the first enactment of Chapter 704 of the 1999 Acts of Assembly is §§ 1, 13, 14 and 15 of 12 the first enactment of Chapter 704 of the 1999 Acts of Assembly are ] amended and reenacted as 13 14 follows: 15 § 1. That, in addition to in lieu of the provisions of § 2.1-343.1, (i) any public body, as defined in 16 § 2.1-341, (a) in the legislative branch of state government or (b) responsible to or under the supervision, direction, or control of the Secretary of Commerce and Trade pursuant to § 2.1-51.40 or the 17 Secretary of Technology pursuant to [ Executive Order Nine (1998), as amended by Executive Order 18 Thirty-Three (1998) § 2.1-51.46 ], or (ii) the State Board for Community Colleges established in 19 20 § 23-215, shall be authorized to hold meetings via electronic communication means pursuant to this act. 21 § 13. By October 15, 2000 April 15, [ 2002 2001 ], public bodies in the legislative branch of state 22 government which conduct electronic communication meetings pursuant to this act shall file with the 23 Joint Rules Committee, as defined in § 51.1-124.3, a report on the total number of electronic 24 communication meetings held; the dates and purposes of the meetings; the types of electronic 25 communication means by which the meetings were held; the number of participants, including the 26 members of the public, at the meetings; and a summary of any public comment received about the 27 electronic communication meetings. 28 § 14. By October 15, 2000 April 15, [2002 2001], public bodies responsible to or under the 29 supervision, direction, or control of the Secretary of Commerce and Trade pursuant to § 2.1-51.40 or the 30 Secretary of Technology pursuant to [ Executive Order Nine (1998), as amended by Executive Order Thirty-Three (1998) § 2.1-51.46 ], which conduct electronic communication meetings pursuant to this 31 act shall file with the Secretary of Commerce and Trade or the Secretary of Technology, respectively, a 32 33 report on the total number of electronic communication meetings held; the dates and purposes of the 34 meetings; the types of electronic communication means by which the meetings were held; the number of 35 participants, including the members of the public, at the meetings; and a summary of any public 36 comment received about the electronic communication meetings. 37 § 15. By October 15, 2000 April 15, [ 2002 2001 ], the State Board for Community Colleges

established in § 23-215 shall file with the Secretary of Education a report on the total number of
electronic communication meetings held; the dates and purposes of the meetings; the types of electronic
communication means by which the meetings were held; the number of participants, including the
members of the public, at the meetings; and a summary of any public comment received about the
electronic communication meetings.
