6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. That § 23-14 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
8 § 23-14. Certain educational institutions declared governmental instrumentalities; powers vested in

9 majority of members of board.

10 The College of William and Mary in Virginia, at Williamsburg; the rector and visitors of Christopher Newport University, at Newport News; Longwood College, at Farmville; the Mary Washington College, 11 at Fredericksburg; George Mason University, at Fairfax; the James Madison University, at Harrisonburg; Old Dominion University, at Norfolk; the State Board for Community Colleges, at Richmond; the 12 13 14 Virginia Commonwealth University, at Richmond; the Radford University, at Radford; the rector and visitors of the University of Virginia, at Charlottesville; the University of Virginia's College at Wise; the 15 Virginia Military Institute, at Lexington; the Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, at 16 Blacksburg; the Virginia Schools for the Deaf and the Blind; the Virginia State University, at 17 Petersburg; Norfolk State University, at Norfolk; the Woodrow Wilson Rehabilitation Center, at 18 19 Fishersville; and the Medical College of Hampton Roads, and the Southwest Virginia Higher Education 20 Center, are hereby classified as educational institutions and are declared to be public bodies and 21 constituted as governmental instrumentalities for the dissemination of education. The powers of every 22 such institution derived directly or indirectly from this chapter shall be vested in and exercised by a 23 majority of the members of its board, and a majority of such board shall be a quorum for the transaction 24 of any business authorized by this chapter. Wherever the word "board" is used in this chapter, it shall be 25 deemed to include the members of a governing body designated by another title.
