15	If a court finds that the Commonwealth, or any of its political subdivisions, has adopted a rule or
16	policy or has taken any action under color of law which deprives any person of life, liberty or property
17	without due process of law, or which denies any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of
18	the law, including any action which (i) discriminates against any person on the basis of race, religion,
19	or gender or (ii) violates the fundamental right and duty of a parent to direct the upbringing of the
20	parent's child, then the court shall allow the prevailing party, other than the Commonwealth, reasonable

21 attorneys' fees as part of the costs.
