Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

7 1. That § 30-86 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

8 § 30-86. Membership; terms; vacancies; chairman and vice-chairman; expenses.

9 A. The Commission shall be composed of nine twelve members, five seven of whom shall be 10 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates from the membership thereof, in accordance with the principles of Rule 16 of the House of Delegates, and four five of whom shall be appointed by the 11 12 Senate Committee on Privileges and Elections from the membership of the Senate. Six members shall 13 constitute a quorum.

14 B. All appointments shall be for terms of four years. Members shall serve for terms coincident with 15 their terms of office. Vacancies occurring other than by expiration of term shall be filled for the unexpired term. Whenever any legislative member fails to retain his membership in the house from 16 which he was appointed, he shall relinquish his membership on the Commission and the appointing 17 authority who appointed such member shall make an appointment from his respective house to complete 18 19 the term. Any member may be reappointed for successive terms. From among its membership, the 20 Commission shall annually elect a chairman and a vice-chairman from among its membership two cochairmen, who are members of different political party caucuses. 21

22 C. Commission members shall receive compensation as provided in § 30-19.12 and shall be 23 reimbursed from funds appropriated or otherwise available to the Commission for reasonable and 24 necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.
