HOUSE BILL NO. 71

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
(Proposed by the House Committee on Privileges and Elections
on January 31, 2000)

(Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate Callahan)

A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 24.2-504 and 24.2-525 of the Code of Virginia, relating to persons entitled to have name printed on ballots in elections and primaries.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That §§ 24.2-504 and 24.2-525 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 24.2-504. Persons entitled to have name printed on ballot.

Only a person fulfilling all the requirements of a candidate shall have his name printed on the ballot for the election. *No person shall have his name printed on the ballot for more than two offices at any one election.*

§ 24.2-525. Persons entitled to have name printed on ballot.

Only a person meeting all the qualifications and fulfilling all the requirements of a candidate, and who has complied with the rules and regulations of his party, shall have his name printed on the ballot provided for the primary election. *No person shall have his name printed on the ballot for more than two offices at any one primary election.*
