6	A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 24.2-504 and 24.2-525 of the Code of Virginia, relating to persons
7	entitled to have name printed on ballots in elections and primaries.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That §§ 24.2-504 and 24.2-525 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 24.2-504. Persons entitled to have name printed on ballot.
11	Only a person fulfilling all the requirements of a candidate shall have his name printed on the ballot
12	for the election. No person shall have his name printed on the ballot for more than two offices at any
13	one election.
14	§ 24.2-525. Persons entitled to have name printed on ballot.
15	Only a person meeting all the qualifications and fulfilling all the requirements of a candidate, and
16	who has complied with the rules and regulations of his party, shall have his name printed on the ballot
17	provided for the primary election. No person shall have his name printed on the ballot for more than
18	two offices at any one primary election
