11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 8.01-377.2 as follows:
12	§ 8.01-377.2. Basis for motion for summary judgment.
13	In any action at law, and in any suit in equity except in a suit for divorce or for the annulment of
14	marriage, if it appears: (i) from the pleadings, any orders issued at a pretrial conference, any
15	admissions, or any sworn affidavits based on personal knowledge in the proceedings, or (ii) when the
16	court sustains a motion to strike the evidence, that the moving party is entitled to judgment, the court
17	shall enter judement upon the entire ease or upon any severable issue including the issue of lightlity

shall enter judgment upon the entire case or upon any severable issue, including the issue of liability
alone, even though there is a genuine issue as to damages. Summary judgment shall not be entered if
any meterial fast is convindly in dispute
