House Amendments in [] — February 1, 2000

A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 22.1-277.02:1, relating to [suspensions and expulsions of students for use of profane or obscene language prohibitions against profane or obscene language or conduct].

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-277.02:1 as follows:

§ 22.1-277.02:1. [Suspension and expulsion for profane or obscene language Profane or obscene language or conduct].

 \bar{A} . Consistent with the procedures set forth in § 22.1-277, school boards shall provide for the suspension and expulsion from school attendance of students for use of profane or obscene language [or conduct] .

B. Each school board shall [revise include in] its standards of student conduct [to incorporate the requirements of this section no later than three months after the date on which this act becomes effective. Prohibitions against profane or obscene language or conduct.]
