11 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 51.1-212 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 51.1-212. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:

15 "Employee" means any (i) member of the Capitol Police Force as described in § 30-34.2:1, (ii) 16 campus police officer appointed under the provisions of Chapter 17 (§ 23-232 et seq.) of Title 23, (iii) game warden in the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries appointed under the provisions of Chapter 17 2 (§ 29.1-200 et seq.) of Title 29.1, (iv) special agent of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control 18 appointed under the provisions of Chapter 1 (§ 4.1-100 et seq.), (v) law-enforcement officer employed 19 20 by the Virginia Marine Resources Commission as described in § 9-169, (vi) correctional officer as the 21 term is defined in § 53.1-1, and including correctional officers employed at a juvenile correction facility 22 as the term is defined in § 66-25.3, (vii) any parole officer appointed pursuant to § 53.1-143, and (viii) any commercial vehicle enforcement officer employed by the Department of State Police-, and (ix) 23 sworn member of the enforcement division of the Department of Motor Vehicles as described in the 24 definition of "law-enforcement officer" in § 9-169. 25

26 "Member" means any person included in the membership of the Retirement System as provided in27 this chapter.

28 "Normal retirement date" means a member's sixtieth birthday.

29 "Retirement System" means the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System.
