HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 114

WHEREAS, the 1999 Frank W. Cox High School girls' volleyball team won the Virginia High School League Group AAA state volleyball championship; and

WHEREAS, the Falcons from Cox High School in Virginia Beach finished with a perfect record of 28-0 and captured the school's second state championship in the past four years; and

WHEREAS, Cox High School won the Beach District regular season championship by finishing undefeated, then swept the Beach District, Eastern Region, and Virginia High School League Group AAA state tournaments; and
