6	Continuing the Joint Subcommittee Studying the Funding Requirements of the Virginia Unemployment
7	Trust Fund.
8	WHEREAS, each year since 1977 a joint subcommittee consisting of five members of the Senate
9	Commerce and Labor Committee and five members of the House Labor and Commerce Committee has
10	met to study the funding requirements of the Virginia Unemployment Trust Fund; and
11	WHEREAS, such joint subcommittee met in 1999 pursuant to House Joint Resolution No. 589
12	(1999) to review the current status of, and long-term projections for, the Virginia Unemployment Trust
13	Fund; and
13	WHEREAS, the Unemployment Trust Fund is financed by Virginia's employers and drawn on by
15	working Virginians who become unemployed and must rely on such fund for unemployment
16	compensation benefits; and
17	WHEREAS, continued legislative oversight of such fund is warranted to ensure its adequacy to meet
18	current and projected benefit payments; now, therefore, be it
19	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Joint Subcommittee
20	Studying the Funding Requirements of the Virginia Unemployment Trust Fund be hereby continued. The
21	joint subcommittee shall be composed of twelve members to be appointed as follows: seven members of
22	the House of Delegates to be appointed by the Speaker, in accordance with Rule 16 of the Rules of the
23	House of Delegates; and five members of the Senate, to be appointed by the Senate Committee on
23 24	Privileges and Elections.
24 25	The direct costs of this study shall not exceed \$15,000.
26	The Division of Legislative Services shall provide staff support for the study. All agencies of the
27	Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the joint subcommittee, upon request.
28	The joint subcommittee shall complete its work in time to submit its written findings and
29	recommendations to the Governor and the 2001 Session of the General Assembly as provided in the
30	procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for processing legislative documents.
31	Implementation of this resolution is subject to subsequent approval and certification by the Joint
32	Rules Committee. The Committee may withhold expenditures or delay the period for the conduct of the
33	study.
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
