11	WHEREAS, the contributions of Virginia's citizens of Scottish descent to the history, culture, and
12	prosperity of the Commonwealth are both numerous and widespread; and
12 13 14	WHEREAS, it is entirely appropriate that Virginia's Scottish-Americans, past and present, be
14	recognized annually for the vital roles they play and have played throughout the history of the
15	Commonwealth; and
16	WHEREAS, the month of September, during which the Scots under William Wallace asserted their
17	independence by defeating the British at Stirling Bridge in 1297, is an especially appropriate time to
18	celebrate Scottish-American heritage; now, therefore, be it
19	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby
20	designate the month of September, in 2000 and in each succeeding year, as Scottish-American Heritage
