A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 58.1-2111.1 and 58.1-2124.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to refunds of motor fuel taxes; bulk feed delivery trucks.

10 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

11 1. That §§ 58.1-2111.1 and 58.1-2124.1 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as 12 follows:

13 § 58.1-2111.1. Refund for solid waste compacting vehicles, ready-mix concrete vehicles and bulk14 feed delivery trucks.

15 Any person who purchases motor fuel in quantities of five gallons or more at any one time for consumption in a solid waste compacting highway vehicle, or a ready-mix concrete highway vehicle, or 16 a bulk feed delivery truck, where the vehicle's equipment is mechanically or hydraulically driven by the 17 internal combustion engine that propels the vehicle, shall be entitled to a refund in an amount equal to 18 thirty-five percent of the tax paid on such fuel. For purposes of this section, a "bulk feed delivery 19 20 truck" means bulk animal feed delivery trucks utilizing power take-off (PTO) driven auger or air feed 21 discharge systems for off-road deliveries of animal feed. The procedure for obtaining such refund shall 22 be as provided in § 58.1-2112.

§ 58.1-2124.1. Refund for solid waste compacting highway vehicles, ready-mix concrete highway
vehicles and bulk feed delivery trucks.

25 Any person who purchases fuel in quantities of five gallons or more at any one time for consumption in a solid waste compacting highway vehicle, or a ready-mix concrete highway vehicle, or a bulk feed 26 *delivery truck*, where the vehicle's equipment is mechanically or hydraulically driven by the internal 27 combustion engine that propels the vehicle, shall be entitled to a refund in an amount equal to thirty-five 28 29 percent of the tax paid on such fuel. For purposes of this section, a "bulk feed delivery truck" means 30 bulk animal feed delivery trucks utilizing power take-off (PTO) driven auger or air feed discharge systems for off-road deliveries of animal feed. The procedure for obtaining such refund shall be as 31 32 provided in § 58.1-2125.
