6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 46.2-828.1, relating to impeding
7	or disrupting certain funeral processions; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 46.2-828.1 as follows:
10	§ 46.2-828.1. Impeding or disrupting certain funeral processions; penalty.
11	A. It shall be unlawful for the operator of any motor vehicle intentionally to impede or disrupt a
12	funeral procession. Any person convicted of violating this subsection shall be guilty of a traffic
13	infraction and shall, in addition to a penalty assessed pursuant to § 46.2-113, be assessed four driver
14	demerit points.
15	B. This section shall apply only to funeral processions that are either (i) travelling under police or
16	sheriff's escort as provided in § 46.2-828 or (ii) escorted or led by vehicles displaying warning lights as
17	provided in § 46.2-1025.
