VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend and reenact § 15.2-1747 of the Code of Virginia, relating to regional criminal justice 3 training academies.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

7 1. That § 15.2-1747 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 8

§ 15.2-1747. Creation of academies.

A. The governing bodies of two or more localities or other political subdivisions or other public bodies hereinafter collectively referred to as "governmental units," may by ordinance or resolution enter 9 10 into an agreement which creates a regional criminal justice training academy under an appropriate name 11 and title containing the words "criminal justice training academy" which shall be a public body politic 12 13 and corporate. Any regional criminal justice training academy created under this article shall also be 14 subject to the requirements of § 9-170.

15 B. The agreement shall set forth (i) the name of the academy, (ii) the governmental subdivision in 16 which its principal office shall be situated, (iii) the effective date of the organization of the academy and the duration of the agreement, (iv) the composition of the board of directors of the academy which may 17 include representation of each locality, political subdivision or governmental entity party to the 18 19 agreement, the members of which shall be the governing body of the academy, (v) the method for 20 selection and the terms of office of the board of directors, (vi) the voting rights of the directors which need not be equal, (vii) the procedure for amendment of the agreement and for addition of other 21 governmental units which are not parties to the original agreement, (viii) the procedure for withdrawal 22 23 from the academy by governmental units electing to do so, and (ix) (viii) such other matters as the 24 governmental units creating the academy deem appropriate. Sheriffs and members of the governing 25 bodies of the governmental units as well as other public officials or employees may be members of the 26 board of directors.

27 C. Any governmental unit not a party to an original agreement creating an academy under this 28 section or § 15.2-1300 may join the academy only by two-thirds vote of the board of directors of the 29 academy. The governing body of the governmental unit seeking to join the academy shall request 30 membership by resolution or ordinance. The board of directors shall provide for the addition of the 31 joining governmental unit to the academy and the number, terms of office, and voting rights of members 32 of the board of directors, if any, to be appointed by the joining governmental unit.

33 D. A governmental unit may withdraw from an academy created under this section or § 15.2-1300 34 only by two-thirds vote of the board of directors of the academy. The governing body of the governmental unit seeking to withdraw from the academy shall signify its desire by resolution or 35 ordinance. The board of directors shall consider requests to withdraw in October 2001, and in October 36 37 of every fifth year thereafter. No requests to withdraw shall be considered at any other time, unless 38 agreed to unanimously. Any withdrawal approved by the board of directors shall be effective on June 30 39 of the following year. The board of directors shall provide for the conditions of withdrawal.

40 C. E. The chairman of the academy board shall serve as a member and as the chairman of an 41 executive committee. The composition of the remaining membership of the executive committee, the 42 term of office of its members and any alternate members, procedures for the conduct of its meetings, 43 and any limitations upon the general authority of the executive committee shall be established in the bylaws of the academy. The bylaws shall also establish any other special standing committees, advisory, 44 45 technical or otherwise, as the board of directors shall deem desirable for the transaction of its affairs.

2. That the provisions of this act shall become effective on July 1, 2001. 46
