10	1. That § 46.2-869 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
1	§ 46.2-869. Improper driving; penalty.
12	Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this article, upon the trial of any person charged with
13	reckless driving where the degree of culpability is slight, the court in its discretion may find the accused
4	not guilty of reckless driving but guilty of improper driving. An attorney for the Commonwealth may
15	change a charge of reckless driving to improper driving at any time after the reckless driving charge is

14 15 16 17 change a charge of reckless driving to improper driving at any time after the reckless driving charge is made [and shall notify the court of such change]. Improper driving shall be punishable as a traffic infraction punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.
