8 Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this article, upon the trial of any person charged with 9 reckless driving where the degree of culpability is slight, the court in its discretion may find the accused 10 not guilty of reckless driving but guilty of improper driving. *However, an attorney for the* 11 *Commonwealth may reduce a charge of reckless driving to improper driving at any time prior to the* 12 *court's decision and shall notify the court of such change.* Improper driving shall be punishable as a 13 traffic infraction punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.
