VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

An Act to amend and reenact § 9-6.25:1 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 62.1-132.11:2, relating to establishment of the Maritime Incident Response Advisory Board.

Approved

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 9-6.25:1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 62.1-132.11:2 as follows:

§ 9-6.25:1. Advisory boards, commissions and councils.

There shall be, in addition to such others as may be designated in accordance with § 9-6.25, the following advisory boards, commissions and councils within the executive branch:

133 § 62.1-132.11:2. *Maritime Incident Response Advisory Board established; duties; composition;*
 134 *appointment; terms.*

135 *The Maritime Incident Response Advisory Board is hereby established and is hereafter referred to as*
 136 *the Board. The purpose of the Board shall be to recommend and direct the development of goals,*
 137 *objectives, policies and plans needed to develop and improve management of maritime fire and incident*
 138 *issues in Hampton Roads and throughout the Commonwealth. This shall include recommendations for*
 139 *the use of state general funds for essential equipment and operation costs, including personnel, material,*
 140 *maintenance, supplies and training to promote an effective and efficient firefighting and incident*
 141 *management force. The Board shall be composed of fourteen members appointed by the Governor as*
 142 *follows: eight members with experience or expertise, personal or professional, in the areas of fire*
 143 *fighting or port management, one representative of the Hampton Roads Maritime Association, one*
 144 *representative of the Hampton Roads Maritime Incident Response Team, one representative of the*
 145 *Virginia Port Authority, the Executive Director of the Port Authority or his designee, the Commissioner*
 146 *of Marine Resources or his designee, and one citizen member.*

147 *Initial appointments shall be made as follows: four members shall be appointed for two years, five*
 148 *members shall be appointed for three years, and five members shall be appointed for four-year terms.*
 149 *The Governor shall designate the term to be served by each appointee at the time of appointment.*
 150 *Thereafter, all members shall be appointed for terms of four years each. Vacancies shall be filled for*
 151 *the unexpired terms. No member shall be eligible to serve more than two successive four-year terms;*
 152 *however, after expiration of a term of three years or less, or after the expiration of the remainder of a*
 153 *term to which he was appointed to fill a vacancy, two additional terms may be served by such member*
 154 *if appointed thereto.*

155 *The Board shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its members. Members of the*
 156 *Board shall receive no compensation for their services as members of the Board, but the*
 157 *nongovernmental member shall receive reasonable expenses. Upon the request of the Board, such staff*
 158 *support as is necessary for the conduct of the Board's business shall be furnished by the Port Authority.*
