12	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
13	1. That § 46.2-1095 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and the Code of Virginia is
14	amended by adding in Article 20 of Chapter 10 of Title 46.2 a section numbered 46.2-1156.1 as
15	follows:
16	§ 46.2-1095. Child restraint devices required; safety belts for children four to sixteen required;
17	penalty.
18	A. Any person who drives on the highways of Virginia any motor vehicle manufactured after
19	January 1, 1968, shall ensure that any child under the age of four whom he transports therein is
20	provided with and properly secured in a child restraint device of a type which meets the standards
21	adopted by the United States Department of Transportation.
22	B. Any person transporting any child at least four years of age, but less than sixteen years of age,
23	shall ensure that such child is provided with and properly secured by an appropriate safety belt system
24	when driving on the highways of Virginia in any motor vehicle manufactured after January 1, 1968,
24 25	equipped or required by the provisions of this title to be equipped with a safety belt system, consisting
26	of lap belts, shoulder harnesses, combinations thereof or similar devices.
27	C. A violation of this section shall not constitute negligence, be considered in mitigation of damages
28	of whatever nature, be admissible in evidence or be the subject of comment by counsel in any action for
29	the recovery of damages in a civil action.
30	D. Any person who violates subsection B of this section shall be subject to a civil penalty of
31	twenty-five dollars to be paid into the state treasury and credited to the Child Restraint Device Special
32	Fund pursuant to § 46.2-1097. No assignment of demerit points shall be made under Article 19
33	(§ 46.2-489 et seq.) of Chapter 3 of this title and no court costs shall be assessed for violations of this
34	section.
35	E. A violation of this section may be charged on the uniform traffic summons form.
36	F. Nothing in this section shall apply to taxicabs, school buses, executive sedans, or limousines, or
37	the rear cargo area of pickup trucks or other vehicles.
38	§ 46.2-1156.1. Transportation of persons less than sixteen years old in pickup truck beds prohibited;
39	exception [; penalty].
40	[No person less than sixteen years old shall be transported in the bed of any pickup truck. The
41	driver of any pickup truck transporting a person in violation of this section shall be guilty of a traffic
42	infraction. No person under sixteen years of age shall be transported in the rear cargo area of any
43	pickup truck on the highways of Virginia. The provisions of this section shall not apply to transportation
44	of persons in the bed of any pickup truck being operated (i) as part of an organized parade authorized
45	by the Department of Transportation or the locality in which the parade is being conducted or (ii) on or
46	across a highway from one field or parcel of land to another field or parcel of land in connection with
47	farming operations.]
