B. The killing of one accidentally by use of a handgun, contrary to the intention of the parties, while in the prosecution of some illegal, but not felonious act, is involuntary manslaughter and punishable as a Class 5 felony.

2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment in state correctional facilities. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation
