2	AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
3	(Proposed by the Senate Committee on Rules
4	on February 14, 2000)
5	(Patron Prior to Substitute—Senator Barry)
6	Establishing a joint subcommittee to study creation of a Northern Virginia Regional Transportation
7	Authority.
8 9	WHEREAS, a transportation infrastructure that contributes to the regional economic development and quality of life must be capable of moving people and goods at a reasonable cost, in a reasonable period
10	of time, and at an appropriate level of safety; and
11	WHEREAS, the Northern Virginia regional transportation infrastructure is inadequate for the region's
12	economic development and quality of life; and
13	WHEREAS, the improvement of the region's transportation infrastructure is hampered by political,
14	jurisdictional, and funding gridlock; now, therefore, be it
15	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That a joint subcommittee be
16	established to study creation of a Northern Virginia Regional Transportation Authority. The joint
17 18	subcommittee shall be composed of 17 members, which shall include nine legislative members and eight nonlegislative citizen members as follows: four members of the Senate, to be appointed by the Senate
10 19	Committee on Privileges and Elections; five members of the House of Delegates, to be appointed by the
20	Speaker, in accordance with the principles of Rule 16 of the House of Delegates; to be appointed by the
21	Fairfax County, one representative of Arlington County, and one representative of Loudoun County,
22	each to be recommended by the respective governing body of the locality and appointed by the Senate
23	Committee on Privileges and Elections; one representative of Stafford County, one representative of
24	Prince William County, and one representative of the City of Alexandria, each to be recommended by
25 26	the respective governing body of the locality and appointed by the Speaker of the House; and two residents of Northern Virginia, one of whom shall be appointed by the Senate Committee on Privileges
20 27	and Elections and one of whom shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates.
28	In conducting its study, the joint subcommittee shall determine the purpose, needs, benefits,
29	authority, composition, responsibility, and funding of a Northern Virginia Regional Transportation
30	Authority. Among the powers and responsibilities of the Northern Virginia Regional Transportation
31	Authority to be considered shall be:
32 33	 The identification of needs and possible solutions; The privatization of solutions;
33 34	3. The acceptance, raising, and disbursement of funds;
35	4. The ability to sell bonds;
36	5. The ability to buy, sell, hold, lease, and condemn property;
37	6. The design, construction, and maintenance of transportation infrastructure or ability to cause the
38	design, construction, and maintenance of transportation infrastructure; and
39 40	7. The funding of transportation infrastructure through direct, indirect, and/or referendum means, including but not limited to: gasoline tax, income tax, tolls, public/private partnership, tax districts,
41	privatization, development fees, and local, state, and federal funding.
42	The direct costs of this study shall not exceed \$12,200.
43	All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the joint subcommittee, upon request.
44	Transportation infrastructure solutions for the movement of people and goods shall consist of all
45	means and modes of transportation. The study shall consider the appropriate relationship of the Northern
46	Virginia Regional Transportation Authority to the Commonwealth of Virginia and its agencies, Maryland
47 48	and its agencies, the District of Columbia and its agencies, the federal government and its agencies, and other public regional entities and authorities.
40 49	The joint subcommittee shall complete its work in time to submit its findings and recommendations
50	to the Governor and the 2001 Session of the General Assembly as provided in the procedures of the
51	Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents.
52	Implementation of this resolution is subject to subsequent approval and certification by the Joint
53 54	Rules Committee. The Committee may withhold expenditures or delay the period for the conduct of the
54	study.

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
