WHEREAS, Larry Stone matriculated at Virginia Military Institute as a history major before enlistingin the Navy; and

WHEREAS, during boot camp, Larry Stone was chosen as his unit's Outstanding Athlete and later,as a yeoman, his skill with communications equipment earned him a job instructing new Seals; and
