WHEREAS, "Grandma" Bailey was a longtime member of the Shiloh Baptist Church in Norfolk, the Women's Missionary Union, and the Hamilton Bible Class; and

WHEREAS, "Grandma" Bailey was a devout Christian woman who touched and improved many lives during her long and productive life; and

WHEREAS, a well-respected citizen and a leader in her church, "Grandma" Bailey will be sorely missed by her large and loving family, by the parishioners of the Shiloh Baptist Church, and by her many friends in the Norfolk community; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly mourn the passing of a fine Virginian, Julia A. "Grandma" Bailey; and, be it
