9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 51.1-212 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 51.1-212. Definitions.
12	As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:
13	"Employee" means any (i) member of the Capitol Police Force as described in § 30-34.2:1, (ii)
14	campus police officer appointed under the provisions of Chapter 17 (§ 23-232 et seq.) of Title 23, (iii)
15	game warden in the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries appointed under the provisions of Chapter
16	2 (§ 29.1-200 et seq.) of Title 29.1, (iv) special agent of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control
17	appointed under the provisions of Chapter 1 (§ 4.1-100 et seq.), (v) law-enforcement officer employed
18	by the Virginia Marine Resources Commission as described in § 9-169, (vi) correctional officer as the
19	term is defined in § 53.1-1, and including correctional officers employed at a juvenile correction facility
20	as the term is defined in § 66-25.3, (vii) any parole officer appointed pursuant to § 53.1-143, and (viii)
21	any commercial vehicle enforcement officer employed by the Department of State Police, and (ix) police
22	officer of the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation, and Substance Abuse Services
23	appointed conservator of the peace pursuant to § 37.1-148.
24	"Member" means any person included in the membership of the Retirement System as provided in
25	this chapter.
26	"Normal retirement date" means a member's sixtieth birthday.

27 "Retirement System" means the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System.
