11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 4, as amended, of Chapter 598 of the 1985 Acts of Assembly is amended and reenacted
13	as follows:
14	§ 4. Membership; terms; officers.—A. The Authority shall consist of thirteeneighteen members: five
15	appointed by the Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, three appointed by the Speaker of the
16 17	Virginia House of Delegates, two appointed by the Senate of Virginia Committee on Privileges and
17	<i>Elections</i> , three appointed by the Mayor of the District of Columbia, two appointed by the Governor of the State of Maryland, and three appointed by the President of the United States. Members <i>appointed by</i>
10 19	the Governor of Virginia representing the Commonwealth of Virginia shall be subject to confirmation by
20	the Virginia General Assembly. For the purposes of doing business, seventen members shall constitute a
21	quorum. The failure of a single appointing official to appoint one or more members, as herein provided,
22	shall not impair the Authority's creation when the other conditions thereof have been met.
23	B. Members shall (i) not hold elective or appointive public office, (ii) serve without compensation,
24	and (iii) reside within the Washington Standard Metropolitan Statistical Area, except that the members
25	appointed by the President of the United States shall be registered voters of states other than Maryland,
26	Virginia or the District of Columbia. The members of the Authority shall be entitled to reimbursement
27	for their expenses incurred in attendance upon the meetings of the Authority or while otherwise engaged
28	in the discharge of their duties.
29	C. Appointments to the Authority shall be for a period of six years. However, initial appointments
30	shall be made as follows: each jurisdiction shall appoint one member for a full six-year term, a second
31	member for a four-year term and in the case of the Commonwealth and the District of Columbia, a third
32 33	member for a two-year term. The Governor of Virginia shall make the final two Virginia initial
33 34	appointments for one two-year and one four-year term. The President shall make subsequent
34 35	appointments for six-year terms. The President shall make one of the initial appointments pursuant to the Metropolitan Washington Airports Amendments Act of 1996 for a four-year term.
33 36	D. EightTen affirmative votes shall be required to approve bond issues and the annual budget of the
37	Authority.
38	E. Each member may be removed or suspended from office only for cause, and in accordance with
39	the laws of the jurisdiction from which he is appointed.
40	F. The Authority shall annually elect one of its members as chairman and another as vice-chairman
41	and shall also elect annually a secretary and a treasurer, or a secretary-treasurer, who may or may not be
42	members of the Authority, and prescribe their powers and duties. The Authority may also appoint from
43	its staff an assistant secretary and an assistant treasurer, or an assistant secretary-treasurer, who shall, in
44	addition to other duties, discharge such functions of the secretary and the treasurer.
45	G. The members of the Authority shall continue to serve until their successors shall be duly
46	appointed. Any person appointed to fill a vacancy shall serve for the unexpired term. Any member of
47 19	the Authority shall be eligible for reappointment for one term.
48 40	H. The members of the Authority, including any nonvoting members, shall not be personally liable
49 50	for any act done or action taken in their capacities as members of the Authority nor shall they be personally liable for any bond, note or other evidence of indebtedness issued by the Authority.
