2	AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
3	(Proposed by the House Committee on Militia and Police
4	on January 29, 2001)
5	(Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate Tata)
6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 18.2-308.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to weapons concealed by
7	disguise; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 18.2-308.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 18.2-308.1. Possession of firearm, stun weapon, or other weapon on school property prohibited.
11	A. If any person possesses any (i) stun weapon or taser as defined in this section, (ii) knife having a
12	metal blade of three inches or longer, (iii) knife, blade, dirk or dagger or any similar item useable as a
13	weapon, regardless of the length of the blade, that appears to be another common object, not clearly
14	recognizable as a knife, blade, dirk or dagger or similar item, or (iii)(iv) weapon, other than a firearm,
15	designated in subsection A of § 18.2-308 upon (i) the property of any public, private or parochial
16	elementary, middle or high school, including buildings and grounds, (ii) that portion of any property
17 18	open to the public used for school-sponsored functions or extracurricular activities while such functions
10 19	or activities are taking place, or (iii) any school bus owned or operated by any such school, he shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
20	B. If any person possesses any firearm designed or intended to propel a missile of any kind while
21	such person is upon (i) any public, private or parochial elementary, middle or high school, including
$\overline{22}$	buildings and grounds, (ii) that portion of any property open to the public used for school-sponsored
23	functions or extracurricular activities while such functions or activities are taking place, or (iii) any
24	school bus owned or operated by any such school, he shall be guilty of a Class 6 felony; however, if
25	the person possesses any firearm within a public, private or parochial elementary, middle or high school
26	building and intends to use, or attempts to use, such firearm, or displays such weapon in a threatening
27	manner, such person shall not be eligible for probation and shall be sentenced to a minimum, mandatory
28	term of imprisonment of five years, which shall not be suspended in whole or in part and which shall be
29	served consecutively with any other sentence.
30	The exemptions set out in § 18.2-308 shall apply, mutatis mutandis, to the provisions of this section.
31	The provisions of this section shall not apply to (i) persons who possess such weapon or weapons as a
32	part of the school's curriculum or activities, (ii) a person possessing a knife customarily used for food
33	preparation or service and using it for such purpose, (iii) persons who possess such weapon or weapons
34	as a part of any program sponsored or facilitated by either the school or any organization authorized by
35 36	the school to conduct its programs either on or off the school premises, (iv) any law-enforcement officer while engaged in his duties as such, (v) any person who possesses a knife or blade which he uses
30 37	customarily in his trade, or (vi) a person who possesses an unloaded firearm which is in a closed
38	container, or a knife having a metal blade, in or upon a motor vehicle, or an unloaded shotgun or rifle
39	in a firearms rack in or upon a motor vehicle. For the purposes of this paragraph, "weapon" includes a
4 0	knife having a metal blade of three inches or longer.
41	As used in this section:
42	"Stun weapon" means any mechanism that is (i) designed to emit an electronic, magnetic, or other
43	type of charge that exceeds the equivalency of a five milliamp sixty hertz shock and (ii) used for the
44	purpose of temporarily incapacitating a person; and
45	"Taser" means any mechanism that is (i) designed to emit an electronic, magnetic, or other type of
46	charge or shock through the use of a projectile and (ii) used for the purpose of temporarily
47	incapacitating a person.
