2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-1167 of the Code of Virginia, relating to charges for vehicle safety*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 46.2-1167 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 46.2-1167. Charges for inspection and reinspection; exemption.

9 A. Each official safety inspection station may charge *no more than:*

10 1. *Thirty dollars for each inspection of any (i) tractor truck, (ii) truck that has a gross vehicle*
11 *weight rating of 26,000 pounds or more, or (iii) motor vehicle that is used to transport passengers and*
12 *has a seating capacity of more than sixteen passengers, including the driver, if performed prior to July*
13 *1, 2002, and fifty dollars for any such inspection performed on or after July 1, 2002;*

14 2. *Five dollars for each inspection of any motorcycle; and*15 3. *Ten dollars for each inspection, but the of any other vehicle.*16 *No such charge shall not be mandatory, however, and no such charge shall be made unless the*
17 *station has previously contracted therefor.*

18 B. Each official safety inspection station may charge one dollar for each reinspection of a vehicle
19 rejected by the station, as provided in § 46.2-1158, if the vehicle is submitted for reinspection within the
20 validity period of the rejection sticker. If a rejected vehicle is not submitted to the same station within
21 the validity period of the rejection sticker or is submitted to another official safety inspection station, ~~ten~~
22 ~~dollars~~ *an amount no greater than that permitted under subsection A of this section* may be charged for
23 the inspection.

24 ~~Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, the maximum fee for the inspection of~~
25 ~~motorcycles shall be one-half the fee permitted for the inspection of other vehicles.~~
