6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 8.01-42.3 as follows:

8 § 8.01-42.3. Civil action for stalking.

9 A. A victim has a civil cause of action against an individual who engaged in conduct that is 10 prohibited under § 18.2-60.3, whether or not the individual has been charged or convicted for the 11 alleged violation, for the compensatory damages incurred by the victim as a result of that conduct, in 12 addition to the costs for bringing the action. If compensatory damages are awarded, a victim may also 13 be awarded punitive damages.

14 B. As used in this section:

15 *"Compensatory damages" includes damages for all of the defendant's acts prohibited by § 18.2-60.3.*

16 "Victim" means a person who, because of the conduct of the defendant that is prohibited under

17 § 18.2-60.3, was placed in reasonable fear of death, criminal sexual assault, or bodily injury to himself
18 or to a minor child of whom the person is a parent or legal guardian.

19 C. No action shall be commenced under this section more than two years after the most recent 20 $\frac{19}{100}$ and $\frac{1}{100}$ $\frac{1}{100$
