A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 15.2-958.2, relating to loans for preservation of historic property.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 15.2-958.2 as follows:

§ 15.2-958.2. Loans for preservation, rehabilitation or repair of historical property.

The preservation of historical property is a governmental function of concern to the Commonwealth and is a public purpose for which public money may be spent. Any locality may make loans of money appropriated from public funds to owners of historically significant property, as defined by the locality and under such terms and conditions as may be specified by the locality, for the purpose of preserving, rehabilitation or repairing such property.
