6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 33.1-191 of the Code of Virginia, relating to contracts with the
7	Virginia Department of Transportation; penalties for violation of terms or conditions of permits or
8	contracts.
9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 33.1-191 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 33.1-191. Contracts.
12 13	A. Every contractor whose bid is accepted shall, before commencing work, enter into a contract with
13	the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner, which shall fully set out the time when work shall
14	commence and when the contract shall be completed, as well as the time and manner for the payment
15	for the work. Whenever the Commissioner or his designee publicly opens and announces all bids
16	received for each invitation to bid, it shall be announced at the same time if the lowest read bid exceeds
17	the maximum tolerance of the Department's estimate for the work represented by that bid.
	B. The contract shall require that the contractor comply with all requirements, conditions, and terms
19	of the contract, including but not limited to environmental permits that are part of the contract. If the
20	contractor violates a contract provision that results in environmental damage or violates environmental
21	laws or environmental permits, the Department may suspend the contractor from future bidding or initiate department. In addition, the Department may recover either (i) the loss or demage that the
22 23	initiate debarment. In addition, the Department may recover either (i) the loss or damage that the Department suffers as a result of such violation or (ii) any liquidated damages established in such
-5	Department suffers as a result of such violation of (ii) any inquitaded damages established in such

contract plus (iii) reasonable attorney's fees and expert witness fees. Any damages and costs collected
under this section shall be deposited into the Transportation Trust Fund and used for transportation

26 purposes as determined by the Commonwealth Transportation Board.

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
