9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 40.1-51.2:2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 40.1-51.2:2. Remedy for discrimination.
13	A. Any employee who believes that he or she has been discharged or otherwise discriminated against
14	by any person in violation of § 40.1-51.2:1 may, within thirty daysone year after such violation occurs,
15	file a complaint with the Commissioner alleging such discharge or discrimination. Upon receipt of such
16	complaint, the Commissioner shall cause such investigation to be made as he deems appropriate. If,
17	upon such investigation, he determines that the provisions of § 40.1-51.2:1 have been violated, he shall
18	attempt by conciliation to have the violation abated without economic loss to the employee. In the event
19	a voluntary agreement cannot be obtained, the Commissioner shall bring an action in a circuit court
20	having jurisdiction over the person charged with the violation. The court shall have jurisdiction, for
21	cause shown, to restrain violations and order appropriate relief, including rehiring or reinstatement of the
22	employee to his former position with back pay plus interest at a rate not to exceed eight percent per
23	annum.
24	B. Should the Commissioner, based on the results of his investigation of the complaint, refuse to
25	issue a charge against the person that allegedly discriminated against the employee, the employee may
26	bring action in a circuit court having jurisdiction over the person allegedly discriminating against the

27 employee, for appropriate relief, *including reasonable attorney's fees*.
