That § 56-557 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:</li> <li>§ 56-557. Definitions.</li> <li>As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:</li> <li>"Affected local jurisdiction" means any county, city or town in which all or a portion of a qualifying transportation facility is located.</li> <li>"Commission" means the State Corporation Commission.</li> <li>"Comprehensive agreement" means the comprehensive agreement between the operator and the responsible public entity required by § 56-566 of this chapter.</li> <li>"Material default" means any default by the operator in the performance of its duties under subsection for § \$ 56-565 of this chapter that jeopardizes adequate service to the public from a qualifying transportation facility and remains unremedied after the responsible public entity has provided notice to the operator and a reasonable cure period has elapsed.</li> <li>"Operator" means the private entity that is responsible for the acquisition, construction, improvement, maintenance and/or operation of a qualifying transportation facility.</li> <li>"Private entity" means any atural person, corporation, limited liability company, partnership, joint venture or other private business entity.</li> <li>"Qualifying transportation facility" means one or more transportation facilities acquired, constructed, improved, maintained and/or operated by a private entity pursuant to this chapter.</li> <li>"Revenues" means the user fees and/or service payments generated by a qualifying transportation facility.</li> <li>"Revenues" means the user fees and/or service payments generated by a qualifying transportation facility.</li> <li>"Revenues" means a contract entered into between a public entity and the operator pursuant to \$ 56-561 of this chapter.</li> <li>"Service contract" means a payments to the operator of a qualifying transportation facility, port facility or similar commercial facility used</li></ul>
