House Amendments in [] — January 11, 2001

A BILL to amend and reenact § 22.1-32 of the Code of Virginia, relating to school board salaries.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 22.1-32 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 22.1-32. Salary of members.

A. The school board of the following counties boards of the several school divisions may pay each of its members an annual salary not to exceed the limits hereinafter set forth:

 147 *provided by charter. However, the salary limits for members of the consolidated school divisions of*
 148 *Williamsburg/James City County, Greensville County/Emporia, and Alleghany County/Clifton Forge*
 149 *shall be consistent with the salary limits established for the relevant county.*

150 ~~C.~~ B. Any school board may, in its discretion, pay the chairman of the school board an additional
 151 salary not exceeding ~~\$1,100~~ 2,000 per year upon passage of an appropriate resolution by (i) the school
 152 board whose membership is elected in whole or in part or (ii) the governing body of the appropriate
 153 county, city, or town whose school board is comprised solely of appointed members.

154 ~~D.~~ C. Any school board may in its discretion pay each of its members mileage for use of a private
 155 vehicle in attending meetings of the school board and in conducting other official business of the school
 156 board. Its members may be reimbursed for private transportation at a rate not to exceed that which is
 157 authorized for persons traveling on state business in accordance with § 2.1-20.10. Whatever rate is paid,
 158 however, shall be the same for school board members and employees of the board.

159 E. Contingent upon finalization of the planned consolidation of the school divisions of Alleghany
 160 County and the City of Clifton Forge, the members of the newly consolidated school board representing
 161 the City of Clifton Forge shall be paid an amount equal to that paid the members of the present school
 162 board of Alleghany County.

163 F. No school board shall request the General Assembly's consideration of an increase in its annual
 164 salary limit as established in this section unless such school board has taken an affirmative vote on the
 165 requested increase. Further,

166 ~~D.~~ No school board whose membership is elected in whole or in part shall be awarded a salary
 167 increase; unless, upon an affirmative vote by such school board, a specific salary increase, within the
 168 limit set herein, shall be approved. Local school boards shall adopt such increases according to the
 169 following procedures:

170 1. A local school board representing a county may establish a salary increase prior to July 1 of any
 171 year in which members are to be elected or appointed, or, if such school board is elected or appointed
 172 for staggered terms, prior to July 1 of any year in which at least one-half of such members are to be
 173 elected or appointed. However, a school board serving a county having the county manager plan of
 174 government and whose membership totals five may establish a salary increase prior to July 1 in any
 175 year in which two of the five members are to be elected or appointed. Such increase shall become
 176 effective on January 1 of the following year.

177 2. A local school board representing a city or town may establish a salary increase prior to December
 178 31 in any year preceding a year in which members are to be elected or appointed. Such increase shall
 179 become effective on July 1 of the year in which the election or appointment occurs.

180 No salary increase may become effective during an incumbent member's term of office; however, this
 181 restriction shall not apply if the school board members are elected or appointed for staggered terms.
