6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 22.1-32 of the Code of Virginia, relating to school board salaries.
7	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
8	1. That § 22.1-32 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
9	§ 22.1-32. Salary of members.
10	A. Any elected school board may pay each of its members an annual salary that is consistent with
11	the salary procedures and limits as provided in Article 1.1 (§ 15.2-1414.1 et seq.) of Title 15.2 or as
12	provided by charter.
13	<i>B.</i> The <i>appointed</i> school board of the following counties may pay each of its members an annual
14	salary not to exceed the limits hereinafter set forth:

147 CD. Any school board may, in its discretion, pay the chairman of the school board an additional 148 salary not exceeding \$1,1002,000 per year upon passage of an appropriate resolution by (i) the school 149 board whose membership is elected in whole or in part or (ii) the governing body of the appropriate 150 county, city, or town whose school board is comprised solely of appointed members.

151 DE. Any school board may in its discretion pay each of its members mileage for use of a private 152 vehicle in attending meetings of the school board and in conducting other official business of the school 153 board. Its members may be reimbursed for private transportation at a rate not to exceed that which is 154 authorized for persons traveling on state business in accordance with § 2.1-20.10. Whatever rate is paid, 155 however, shall be the same for school board members and employees of the board.

156 E. Contingent upon finalization of the planned consolidation of the school divisions of Alleghany 157 County and the City of Clifton Forge, the members of the newly consolidated school board representing 158 the City of Clifton Forge shall be paid an amount equal to that paid the members of the present school 159 board of Alleghany County.

160 F. No appointed school board shall request the General Assembly's consideration of an increase in its 161 annual salary limit as established in subsections B and C of this section unless such school board has 162 taken an affirmative vote on the requested increase. Further, no *elected* school board whose membership is elected in whole or in part shall be awarded a salary increase, unless, upon an affirmative vote by 163 164 such school board, a specific salary increase, within the limit set herein, shall be approved. Local school boards shall adopt such increases according to the following procedures: 165

166 1. A local school board representing a county may establish a salary increase prior to July 1 of any 167 year in which members are to be elected or appointed, or, if such school board is elected or appointed 168 for staggered terms, prior to July 1 of any year in which at least one-half of such members are to be 169 elected or appointed. However, a school board serving a county having the county manager plan of 170 government and whose membership totals five may establish a salary increase prior to July 1 in any 171 year in which two of the five members are to be elected or appointed. Such increase shall become 172 effective on January 1 of the following year.

173 2. A local school board representing a city or town may establish a salary increase prior to December 174 31 in any year preceding a year in which members are to be elected or appointed. Such increase shall 175 become effective on July 1 of the year in which the election or appointment occurs.

176 No salary increase may become effective during an incumbent member's term of office; however, this 177 restriction shall not apply if the school board members are elected or appointed for staggered terms.

178 2. That the school board of the County of Northumberland may pay its members an annual salary 179 not to exceed \$2,400.00 until such time as its members are elected and duly sworn into office as 180 authorized by the referendum held in 2000.

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
