10	WHEREAS, the Virginia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board is charged with the overall regulation
11	and control of the sale of alcoholic beverages in the Commonwealth; and
12	WHEREAS, the Board is empowered to buy, import and sell alcoholic beverages other than beer and
13	wine not produced by farm wineries, and to have alcoholic beverages other than beer and wine not
14	produced by farm wineries in its possession for sale; and
15	WHEREAS, to accomplish its mission, the Board may determine the localities in which government
16	stores may be established and operated, subject to local referendum; and
17	WHEREAS, each year excess profits from money collected by the Board is redistributed to localities
18	according to a formulary developed by law; and
19	WHEREAS, state statute requires that government stores be closed on Sundays, Thanksgiving Day,
20	Christmas Day, and New Year's Day, as well as any other periods or on such days as the Board may
21	direct; now, therefore, be it
22	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Virginia Department of
23	Alcoholic Beverage Control be requested to study the feasibility of closing government stores on the
24	state holiday designated for Martin Luther King, Jr.
25	All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage
26	Control for this study, upon request.
27	The Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control shall complete its work in time to submit its findings
28	and recommendations to the Governor and the 2002 Session of the General Assembly as provided in the
29	procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative
30	documents.
