### HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 52

*Celebrating the life of Madeline B. Cadd.*

Agreed to by the House of Delegates, February 23, 2001

WHEREAS, Madeline B. Cadd of Roanoke, an influential member of the Democratic Party on the local and state levels, died on February 16, 2001; and

WHEREAS, Madeline Cadd was a longtime member of Waverly Place Baptist Church and an active member of the Ladies Garment Workers Union, for which she served as business agent; and

WHEREAS, Madeline Cadd was active in Democratic Party politics at the state and local levels for many years, and she was given a key to the City of Roanoke by former Mayor Noel Taylor in honor of her dedication and service; and

WHEREAS, Madeline Cadd will be missed by her family, the parishioners of Waverly Place Baptist Church, and her countless friends and colleagues in the Roanoke community; now, therefore, be it
