AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the Senate Committee on Transportation

on February 1, 2001)

- (Patrons Prior to Substitute—Senators Williams and Whipple [SB 1213])
- A BILL to amend and reenact § 33.1-23.03 of the Code of Virginia, relating to preparation of a statewide transportation plan by the Commonwealth Transportation Board.
- Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
- 9 1. That § 33.1-23.03 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

10 § 33.1-23.03. Secretary to develop and update Statewide Transportation Plan.

A comprehensive review of the statewide construction needs of all the highway systems in the Commonwealth shall be conducted by the Department at least once in every five-year period. Such review shall be conducted for the purpose of producing an inventory of all construction needs for all systems to a target year twenty years in the future based on standards established by the Department of Transportation. The first report shall be presented to the General Assembly and local officials no later than October 1, 1989

17 The Commonwealth Transportation Board shall conduct a comprehensive review of statewide 18 transportation needs in a Statewide Transportation Plan setting forth an inventory of all transportation needs for all systems, and based upon this inventory, establishing goals, objectives, and priorities 19 20 covering at least a twenty-year planning horizon, in accordance with federal transportation planning requirements. This plan shall embrace all modes of transportation and include technological initiatives. 21 22 This Statewide Transportation Plan shall be updated as needed, but no less than once every five years. 23 The plan will provide consideration of projects and policies affecting all transportation modes and promote economic development, intermodal connectivity, environmental quality, accessibility for people 24 25 and freight, and transportation safety. Each such plan shall be summarized in a public document and 26 made available to the general public upon presentation to the Governor and General Assembly. 2. That the first plan prepared in accordance with the provisions of this act shall be presented on 27

28 December 1, 2002 .
