VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 2.1-27.2:01 and 22.1-17.4, relating to the Virginia World War II Veterans Appreciation Week and certain honorary high school 3 4 diplomas.

7 Whereas, between 1939 and 1945, World War II — the most devastating war to occur on earth — 8 raged across Europe, Africa, Asia, and the Pacific islands; and

9 Whereas, more than 16 million young Americans, many of whom left high school as mere teenagers 10 to take up this cause, served in the United States Armed Forces during this period, defending their 11 country and humanity; and

12 Whereas, the economic and personal loss suffered by these young Americans can only be imagined, 13 with lives interrupted and inexorably altered; and

14 Whereas, upon returning, many of these young Americans were unable to resume their schooling 15 because of economic and other personal reasons; and

Whereas, these young Americans reentered society and made significant contributions to our country 16 through their hard work as civilians, while gaining substantial knowledge and skills through work; and 17

Whereas, in the golden years of their lives, the veterans of World War II have earned and do deserve 18 19 our esteem and gratitude and our acknowledgement that without their sacrifices, our lives would not be 20 the same as they are today; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 21

22 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 2.1-27.2:01 and 22.1-17.4 as 23 follows:

24 § 2.1-27.2:01. Virginia World War II Veterans Appreciation Week; honorary diplomas to be awarded 25 under certain circumstances during such week.

26 A. In recognition of the sacrifice of the members of the United States Armed Forces who served in 27 World War II, the first full week in September, i.e., the week that was the first full official week of peace 28 in 1945, shall hereby be designated the Virginia World War II Veterans Appreciation Week, beginning 29 in September 2001.

30 In accordance with the Board of Education's guidelines as authorized by § 22.1-17.4, any veteran of 31 World War II may apply for a Commonwealth of Virginia World War II Veteran Honorary High School 32 Diploma by filing with the Virginia Board of Education a statement declaring that:

1. During the years between 1939 and 1945, he served in any branch of the United States Armed 33 34 Forces;

35 2. He was drafted or did enlist in the United States Armed Forces while still enrolled as a secondary 36 school student in any school in any state or territory of the United States or any school located on or 37 associated with a United States military base or embassy; and

38 3. He was unable to resume his secondary education upon returning to civilian life.

39 B. Upon receiving a statement in compliance with this section and § 22.1-17.4 that has been filed in 40 accordance with its guidelines, the Board of Education shall award the veteran a Commonwealth of 41 Virginia World War II Veteran Honorary High School Diploma. Such diploma shall be delivered during 42 Virginia World War II Veterans Appreciation Week.

43 § 22.1-17.4. Certain honorary diplomas to be issued under specific circumstances.

44 A. Any veteran of World War II may apply to the Board of Education for a Commonwealth of 45 Virginia World War II Veteran Honorary High School Diploma by filing, in compliance with Board guidelines, a statement declaring that: 46

1. During the years between 1939 and 1945, he served in any branch of the United States Armed 47 48 Forces:

49 2. He was drafted or did enlist in the United States Armed Forces while still enrolled as a secondary 50 school student in any school in any state or territory of the United States or any school located on or associated with a United States military base or embassy; and 51 52

3. He was unable to resume his secondary education upon returning to civilian life.

53 B. The Board of Education shall establish guidelines setting forth the timelines and procedures for 54 applying for such diplomas. Upon the filing of the required statement in accordance with its guidelines, 55 the Board of Education shall award the veteran a Commonwealth of Virginia World War II Veteran 56 Honorary High School Diploma. Such diplomas shall be delivered to eligible veterans during the first **SB1210ER**

full week in September that has been designated, in accordance with § 2.1-27.2:01, as the Virginia
World War II Veterans Appreciation Week.
