9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 46.2-1167 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 46.2-1167. Charges for inspection and reinspection; exemption.
12	Each official safety inspection station may charge ten dollars a fee for each inspection, but the
13	charge shall not be mandatory. No such charge shall be made unless the station has previously
14	contracted therefor. Any such fee shall be fair and reasonable, based on the service provided, but in no
15	event shall any such fee exceed twenty dollars for inspection of a passenger car or fifty dollars for
16	inspection of a truck.
17	Each official safety inspection station may charge one dollar for each reinspection of a vehicle
18	rejected by the station, as provided in § 46.2-1158, if the vehicle is submitted for reinspection within the
19	validity period of the rejection sticker. If a rejected vehicle is not submitted to the same station within
20	the validity period of the rejection sticker or is submitted to another official safety inspection station, ten
21	dollars an amount no greater than that charged by that station for inspection of similar vehicles may be
22	charged for the inspection.
22	Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, the maximum fee for the inspection of

Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, the maximum fee for the inspection of
motorcycles shall be one-half the fee permitted for the inspection of other vehicles.
