- 1. That § 18.2-152.5 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - § 18.2-152.5. Computer invasion of privacy.

- A. A person is guilty of the crime of computer invasion of privacy when he uses a compu computer network and intentionally examines without authority any employment, salary, credit other financial or personal information relating to any other person. "Examination" under this s requires the offender to review the information relating to any other person after the time at which offender knows or should know that he is without authority to view the information displayed.
 - B. The crime of computer invasion of privacy shall be punishable as a Class 3 1 misdemeanor.
