10	1. That § 30-19.14 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 30-19.14. Office expenses.
12	A. Each member of the General Assembly shall receive as reimbursement an allowance for office
13	expenses and supplies such sums as shall be set forth in the general appropriation act.
14	B. Notwithstanding any provision of law, all payments to members of the General Assembly made in
15	accordance with subsection A shall be subject to such taxes and tax withholding as applicable to other
16	nonvouchered allowances, except for any member of the General Assembly who has established an
17	individual "accountable plan" as defined in § 1-62.2 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code Tax
18	Regulations.

19 2. That this act represents a restatement of current law and practice.
